“And what are those?”, shrieked James, “They look like horns!”



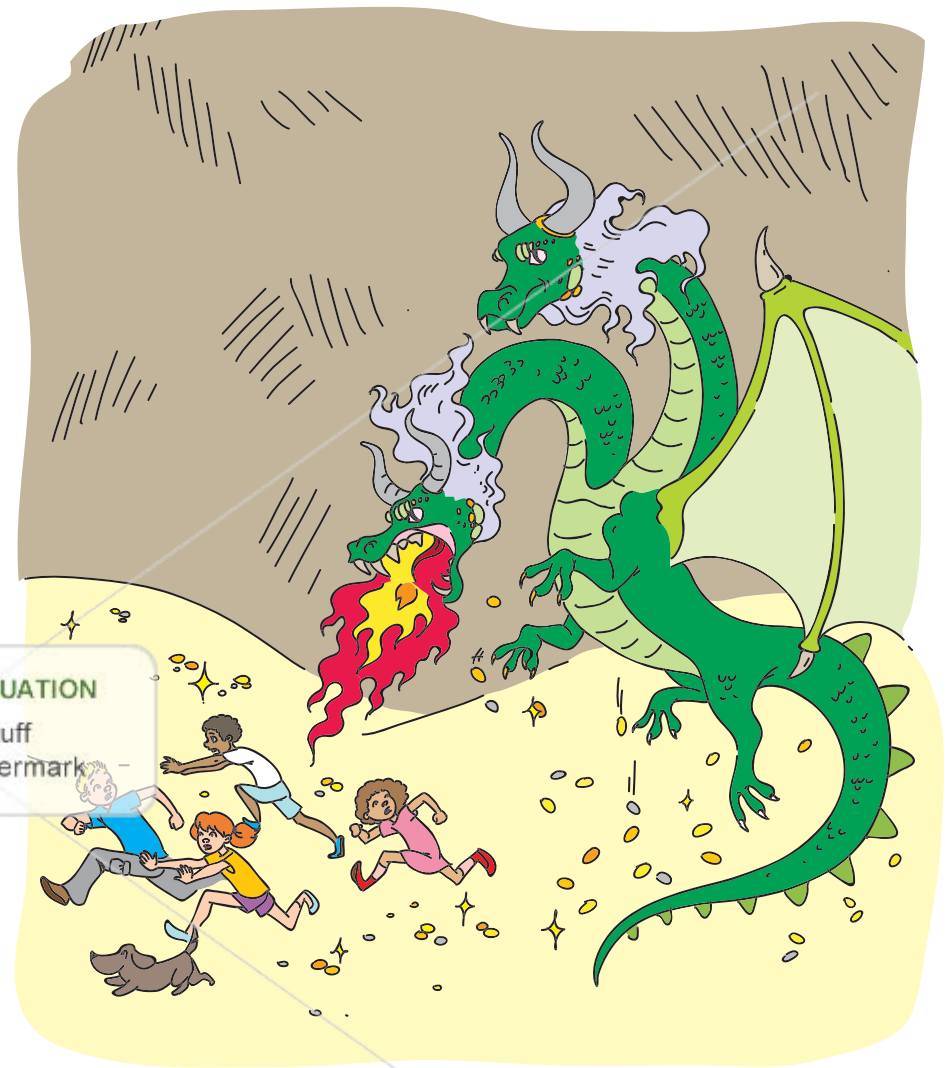
Then Meg screamed, “Aggggh! What is that over there? It looks just like an eye!”

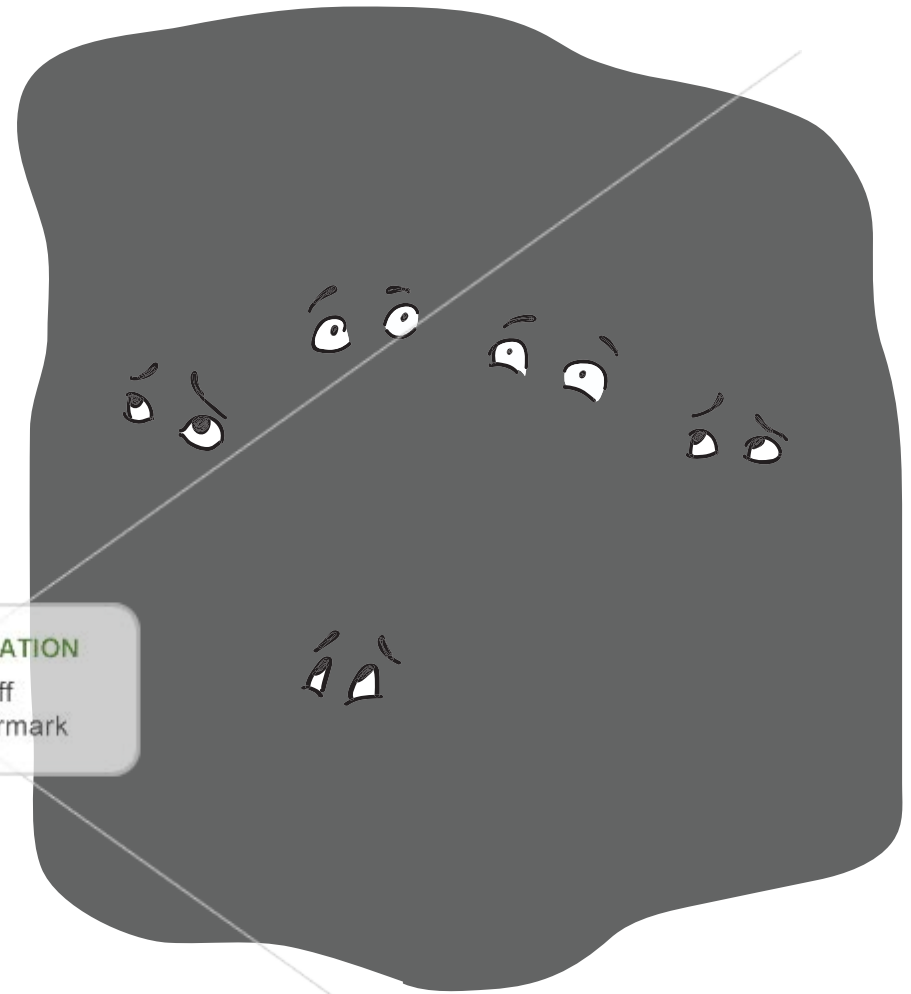
Suddenly, there was a loud roar as something huge rose up from under the treasure. “Run!”, screamed Sue, “It’s a dragon!”



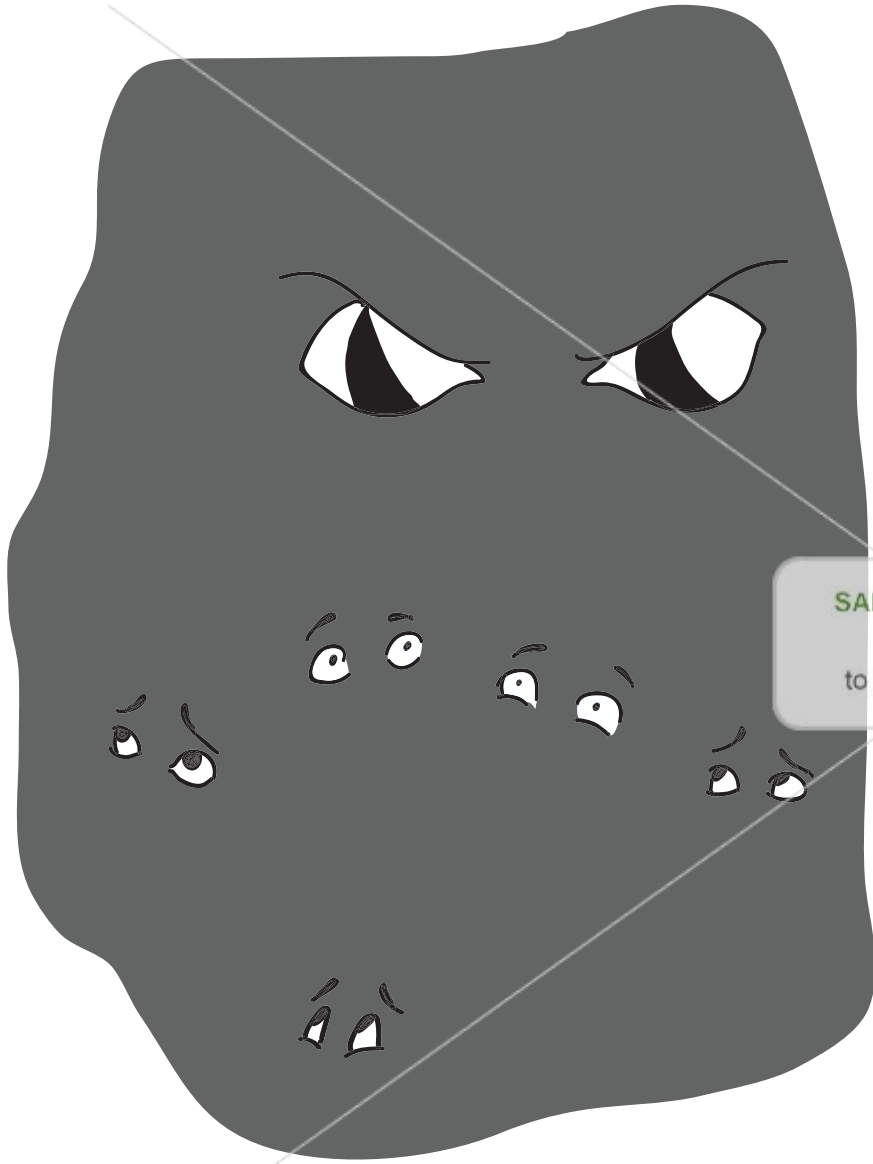
